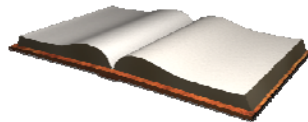


Red Nose Day - Friday 13th March 2009

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Breakfast Club is open to all children registered at Reigate Parish Church School and their siblings at Reigate Parish Playgroup.
2. All fees must be promptly on receipt of monthly invoice. Cheques should be payable to Reigate Parish Church School.
3. A completed registration form must be submitted at least 2 days prior to any child using the club.
4. Parents must notify the Breakfast Club leaders of any changes to the registration form as soon as they occur (in particular, emergency contact numbers)
5. Children can use the Breakfast Club without pre-booking provided that a registration form has been completed at least 48 hours in advance.
6. All children should be dropped off by 8.20am if they are eating breakfast at the club.
7. The authorised person delivering the child at Breakfast Club must sign the child in to Breakfast Club to enable accurate registration. Authorised persons must be over 16 years of age.
8. The Breakfast Club reserves the right to exclude any child from the club whose behaviour is disruptive and prevents them from providing a safe, stimulating and happy environment for other children. This option will only be used in extreme circumstances and as a last resort after extensive consultation with parents/carers and the child concerned.

The Breakfast Club has a responsibility to contact Social Services if we are concerned in any way about the safety of a child. The Breakfast Club has a duty of care for the welfare of the child and maintains strong links with the School and will share any concerns with the School, Child Protection Officer and SENCo
