This week at Breakfast Club we have been celebrating St George with lots of flag making. The children have managed to eat 26 sausages, 5 tins of baked beans and 1 egg.



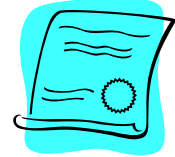
#### Eco Club for Year 1
