Thank you to all the families who returned their questionnaires. The Governors and I are studying the results ready to share them with you. Scooters

Mr Sears requests

We have noticed in the sunny weather that parents are lingering in the playground once the children have gone in to school. We should be shutting and locking the gates by **9.05 am**. This is for all the children's safety. Please leave the playground once your child has gone in and have a chat on the other side of the gates!

Car Park:

Please ensure that if you use the car park that you follow our simple rules:

- Only park in designated bays
- **NO DOUBLE PARKING**
- Look for spaces from the turning circle. **DO NOT DRIVE IN AND REVERSE OUT.**
- Remind all the children that it is a car park and they shouldn't run out between the cars.

Please can you ensure that you drive in and out of the car park very slowly. We have had several near misses due to inappropriate speed. It should not be necessary to display a speed limit in a school's car park as, obviously, there are young children present whose safety must come first.

Police advice re parking around the school remains the same:

- Leave a big enough gap—wide enough for a double buggy to get by (1.2m)
- Only park on one side of the road
- Do not obstruct driveways
- Do not park on zigzag lines
- Do not park within 10m of a junction
- Do not park on corners

The Governors are only able to offer parents access to the car park if it is used safely. If the problem continues, the car park will be shut to school and playgroup parents.
